Dear Parents

Welcome back to a new year and a new term. I hope that you all enjoyed the holiday. We finished off our Christmas festivities with the class parties and the distribution of presents by the wonderful Mickey & Minnie Mouse. – a great end to our celebrations.

The School Census will take place on Thursday 18th January. The take up of Universal Free School Meals on that day is recorded and the school is reimbursed for that number for the rest of the school year, whether the number increases or not. Previously, the school has carried that shortfall, but this has a significant impact on our already overburdened budget and results in less money available for other resources. We would therefore encourage all children to have the free school meal on census day if they are entitled to it. We will assume that all children in Year 1, 2 & Reception will have the FSM unless you inform us of the reason why your child is not participating. Our catering company, Chartwells have also produced a special pizza menu to appeal to the children.

We have a continuing issue with headlice in the school, especially in the younger children. Please check your child or children's hair very regularly and treat where appropriate.

Thank you to everyone who supported the Save the Children Christmas Jumper Day. We collected over £40 for the charity.

ZERO GRAVITY We are delighted to inform you that we have arranged gymnastic sessions for Owls & Badgers Classes. They will begin on Thursday 18th January for 10 weeks and will be instead of our usual swimming sessions. This will involve the children being transported by bus as the sessions will be held in Saltash. The bus will collect the

children as usual after lunch each Thursday and return them to the school for normal home time. Please be aware that parents who normally collect their children from the swimming pool will need to come to the school for 3.15pm for normal collection. The cost of the sessions will be covered by the school but there will be a charge for the transport.

All children will need suitable PE clothes and footwear for indoor gym activities.

FOOTBALL: club has started and is open to children from Year 1 – Year 6. As a general rule for football, if it has rained for most of the day and is still raining at 3.00pm, the session will be cancelled. If the session begins in adequate conditions but is interrupted by the weather, we shall as speedily as possible head for Owls Class and play indoor games.
