The Arrival of the Roman Empire to Britain: exploring a civilisation and its impact on Britain.

The Fall of the Roman empire and the arrival of the Anglo Saxons. From Raiders to settlers and the influence of King Alfred.

Discovering the Shang Dynasty of China: exploring an ancient civilisation and its legacy and influence.

Behind Enemy Lines: exploring the causes of the First and Second World Wars. Learning about life for people during times of conflict and considering the impact of the events on technology and society.

Marvellous Maya: Explore the ancient civilisation of the Indus and its influence, rise and fall. Compare and contrast to other civilisations studied through KS2

Explore the ancient Egyptian civilisation its features and nature, and the role of the Nile

Explore changing transport: from Rivers and canals to the Railways and the changes this brought nationally and locally for trade and tourism as part of the Industrial Revolution. Explore the role of Brunel locally.

Learn about your family and family tree, talk to people about how life has changed as they have grown up.

Think about significant people who have changed health and care. Learn about the changes in medicine and health and the life of Mary Seacole and Florence Nightingale.

Explore what life was like in 1666—discover how the Great fire started and how it affected London.
