ROAD SAFETY

NEW WASTE COLLECTION ARRANGEMENTS

As many of you will be aware Cornwall Council has changed its rubbish [waste} bin collection systems and this has also affected us as a school.

We have had to move to a business collection and are now paying business rates, per bin, for our rubbish and recycling to be collected.

Like households, we also have to separate our food waste and are liable to the same sort of fines if we mix this with other rubbish and recycling.

For this reason, we are now asking that children who bring a packed lunch to school, take home any uneaten food and food waste [fruit peel etc], to help us keep our volume of waste down and also to avoid staff having to sort through the bins every day.
