Dear Parents

I am delighted to announce that we have achieved our goal of purchasing two dehumidifiers for the school and they have already been installed in the classroom. I have been amazed at the wonderful response that the 'Just Giving' page received and would like to thank not only Simon Hancock for his idea and arranging everything on our behalf but also everyone who contributed to the page so willingly.

We are pleased that the current Children In Need total we have collected is £143 which was a superb effort – especially as Owls Class were at Launceston College. Thank you to everyone who supported the fundraising at the school. It's not too late to send a donation if you wish.

As a result of budgetary restraints, we have made the decision that we will no longer allow school dinner money arrears to exceed £25 with effect from the Spring term. This is the equivalent of ten school meals. We can accept payment daily, weekly, half-termly or termly in advance only. Please pay promptly, as due to guidelines from Cornwall Council, we should not be allowing arrears to occur under any circumstances. All payments should be in named envelopes.

Please remember for **all** children throughout the school, that if you receive income support and other benefits (but not Working Tax Credit), you may be eligible for Free School Meals. Please ask in the office for an application form as the school receives extra money for each child on the register.

The weather has turned very much colder so please ensure that all children have coats, hats and gloves with them each day.
