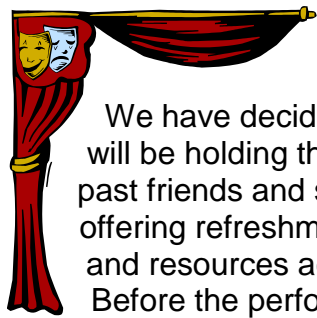
Well done all of you.
