

Each week your child will be given spellings and number facts to practise and they should also try to read with an adult or independently for 10-20 minutes, 5 times a week. Pupils should also try to complete 1 or 2 of the tasks on the grid each week. Homework books can be handed in to class teachers on a Tuesday for checking and will be returned to children on a Thursday.
