Dear Parents

Welcome back to a new year and a new term. I hope that you all enjoyed the holiday. We finished off our Christmas festivities with the class parties and the distribution of presents by Father Christmas – a great end to our celebrations.

As we start the New Year, we are aiming to improve the children's behaviour whilst they are in school. In every class there are Yellow and Red card posters describing inappropriate behaviour. You will also find a copy of it at the end of the Newsletter so that all parents are familiar with expected standards.

The school census will take place on Thursday 16th January. As parents have previously been informed, the take up of Universal Free School Meals on this day is recorded and the school is reimbursed for that number for the rest of the school year, whether the number increases or not. Previously, the school has carried that shortfall, but this has a significant impact on our already overburdened budget and results in less money available for other resources. We therefore encourage **all** children to have the free school meal if they are entitled to it and will assume that every child will have a Free School Meal. There will also be a special menu of an All Day Breakfast.

We are currently having work carried out in the shelter at the bottom of the playground and so therefore no ball games will be allowed during break or lunchtime.

SPORT & CLUBS

All Clubs will start week commencing 13th January, except netball / basketball which will start on Monday 20th January.

For all clubs, if your child is given a place, it is very important that they commit to the club and attend every week – unless there are exceptional circumstances.

SWIMMING: Swimming lessons will start on Monday 13th January 2020 for years 3 - 6 only. The bus will leave the school at 12.20pm and will return in time for the end of school. All children must have a costume and towel – swim aids, such as armbands are provided by St Mellion. The school will continue to pay for the tuition and pool hire so parents will only have to pay for the coach. Consent forms are enclosed with the Newsletter with full details and must be returned to school as children will not be able to attend without it.

NETBALL OR BASKETBALL Mr Horn will start a netball / basketball club for the older children on Mondays starting **Monday 20th January**. This will be for years 2 to 6 and will finish at 4.15pm.

FOOTBALL (younger children): The Club will start on **Tuesday 14th January** and will continue to run on **Tuesdays** run by Plymouth Argyll and is open to children from Year 1 – Year 3.

PIC N MIX FRIDAY SPORTS Children will be able to choose which sports they would like to play each week. This club will be run by Mr Horn and will start on Friday 17th January 2020. It is open for children from Year 2 – Year 6 and will finish at 4.15pm
